I am an Artist!

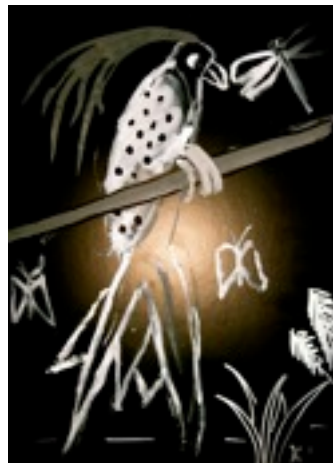
Grade 2 through to Middle School
